Did you ever wonder where the animals and plants, stars and angels, insects and people came from? Did they just get here on their own? No, they did not! God made them. And God didn't make them not just any old way. He made them good. He made them just right for His good plan for the world.

What was God's good plan for the world? He planned for everything He made to show us what He's like so we could know delight in how wonderful He is.

Meaning:

Long, long ago, God made everything. He made everything in the heavens up above us--all the twinkly stars, the sun and moon and everything else. He made everything on earth--all the animals, the trees and flowers, and the tall, snowy mountains. He made the fish that swim in the seas and the birds that fly in the air, too. Most special of all, He made people. Everything God made was just right! He called it very good and it was!



2. What did God use to make these things?


God only used His powerful word. He spoke and they came to be. That's it!






