Long ago, a man named Edwin Hatch was thinking about this Bible truth, too. He wrote the words to a hymn called "Breathe on Me, Breath of God" We're going to learn two verse from it.

We are all sinners. We were made to love and obey God, but we have all turned away from that most wonderful of lives. Only God can change us and He can, by His Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit is nicknamed the "Breath of God." Our breath fills our body with the air that it needs to live. The Holy Spirit fills God's people with Himself so that they can know and love God and have His eternal life. God will send His Holy Spirit to work this way in us when we turn from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior. This song is a prayer asking Him to do this.

Breathe/Breath

Left arm, palm down, faces right with index finger extended and touching elbow of right arm, which points up with index finger extended up. Right arm is then pivoted down in an arc until it rests just above left elbow.



Me

Point to self with right index finger.



Life

Upturned thumbs of "A" hands move upward in front of chest in unison.



Anew

Hold both hands, palm up. Right palm sweeps along the left palm then up slightly.



Love

Fists are crossed on chest, palms facing body.



Thou

Right open hand moves up a short ways from shoulder height..




Do



Fingertips of right "V" hand are placed in palm of left flat hand which palm is facing right and fingertips facing forward. Fingertips of right "V" hand are then lifted from left palm, pivoted clockwise then placed back down on left palm.

Do
Move open hands, palms down side to side at the same time.

Endure
Tip of right "A" hand is placed behind left "A" hand, knuckles facing forward. Move both hands forward in unison.

Truth
Place the right index finger, palm facing left, on lower lip. Move the finger up and then out, making an arc.



Hold right "V" hand, palm facing forward, in front of face, with index and middle fingers bend forward, imitating fangs. Move hand forward a ways.




Evil

Downward right palm is held in front of the body and make a number of downward arcs as it moves from left to right, as if patting heads of several children.



More
Bring fingers of both "and" hands together.



Holy Spirit
Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up. Then touch the thumbs and index fingers of both "T" hands to each other, right hand above left, palms facing each other. Draw hands apart in an upward motion.



Ask
Hold flat palms apart in front of chest. Gradually bring palms together as you pivot them both up and back, until they are joined and resting upon chest, pointing upward.
