
Long ago, a man named John Newton was thinking about this Bible truth, too. He wrote the words a hymn called "Amazing Grace" We're going to learn a few verses from it.

We would all be lost in our sins and rebellion forever, if it were not for God sending His Son Jesus. Jesus kept God's laws perfectly and offered up Himself as the perfect sacrifice needed for sin. Then He gives to all who repent of their sins and trust in Him the amazingly gracious gift of salvation. He first gives them "sight" to make them aware of their sinfulness and to fear His judgment, then as they turn to Him, He relieves their fears by taking away their guilt the hour they believe.




**Grace**

Begin with fingertips of right hand touching, palm facing forward. Twist wrist around, bringing hand down and palm facing body, while at the same time opening up the fingers and flattening the hand



**Sound**

Place right index finger at right ear, then make "S" hands with both hands in front of chest. Move both hands forcefully in and out a few times.



**Me**

Point to self with right index finger.



**Once Was**

Hold left hand in front of body, fingers together, pointing to the right. Right hand, fingers together and pointing to the left, rests on left palm then moves quickly towards the body.



**Lost**

Fingers of both upturned hands touch in middle, then are turned over and swept forward and out to each side.



**Now**

Both "Y" hands, palms down, are held in front of body, then dropped down a short ways.



**Found**

Right "C" hand makes a few circular motions near face from right to left.



**Blind**

Index and middle finger of "V" hand are placed in front of eyes and lowered slightly.



**See**

Index and middle finger of right "V" hand, palm facing in, are placed near eyes then moved forward.


**Amazing Grace, v.2**

**Grace**

Begin with fingertips of right hand touching, palm facing forward. Twist wrist around, bringing hand down and palm facing body, while at the same time opening up the fingers and flattening the hand



**Taught**

Place both "And" hands at front sides of the head,, fingers facing each other. Move both hands forward simultaneously.



**Heart**

Middle fingers are used to traced out the shape of a heart on upper left chest.



**Fear**

Move hands, fingers together, across chest inward at the same time, opening hands as you move inward.



**Relieved**

"F" hands are crossed in front of body, palms facing in. Move both hands out to the side while pivoting the palms to face outward.




**Precious**

Make claw hands in front of chin, then bring down and close into fists.



**Appear**

Hold index fingers together, pointing forward and slightly to the right. Bring them apart a few inches as they pivot towards the left, then bring them back together to touch again as they point out and slightly to the left.



**Hour**

Point fingers of left flat hand up, palm facing forward. Move index finger of right "D" hand in a full clockwise circle, beginning and ending with index finger pointing to "12:00."



**Believed**

Right flat hand, palm facing body, starts over heart, then circles around the left flat hand, also palm facing body, which is held a short distance from chest.


about this Bible verse:




**Saved**  
 "S" hands are crossed in front of body, palms facing in. Move both hands out to the side while pivoting the palms to face outward.



**Us**  
 Right index finger touches right shoulder, then moves left to touch left shoulder.



**Washing**  
 Middle, bent finger of right "5" hand touches middle of left open palm, palms facing each other. Then middle, bent finger of left "5" hand touches middle of right open palm, palms facing each other.



**Regeneration**  
 Fingers of left flat hand are placed on top of fingers of right flat hand. Right flat hand then slips down and forward beyond the left hand. Then, hold left hand, in "5" position palm facing right, in front of chest. Fingers of right hand are brought up and into the left palm in an arc movement.



**Renewal**  
 Hold both hands, palm up. Right palm sweeps along the left palm then up slightly.



**Spirit, Holy Spirit**  
 Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up. Then touch the thumbs and index fingers of both "T" hands to each other, right hand above left, palms facing each other. Draw hands apart in an upward motion.



**Poured Out**  
 Right "A" hand is held above left "S" hand on chest, palms facing body. Both hands move forward and down in an arc, ending with open hands, palms facing up and fingers facing each other.



**Generously**  
 Right flat hand, palm facing body, starts over heart, then circles around the left flat hand, also palm facing body, which is held a short distance from chest..



**Jesus Christ**  
 Middle, bent finger of right "5" hand touches middle of left open palm, palms facing each other. Then middle, bent finger of left "5" hand touches middle of right open palm, palms facing each other.





Middle fingers are used to traced out the shape of a heart on upper left chest.



**Spirit, Holy Spirit**  
Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up. Then touch the thumbs and index fingers of both "T" hands to each other, right hand above left, palms facing each other. Draw hands apart in an upward motion.



**Within**  
Right "S" hand is placed across left "S" hand then brought over and down a bit.
