**Take**

Both both open hands, palms down, toward chest while simultaneously closing hands so fingertips are resting on the chest.

**My, Mine**

Right "5" hand is placed on chest.

**Will**

Fingertips of right "V" hand are placed in palm of left flat hand which palm is facing right and fingertips facing forward. Fingertips of right "V" hand are then lifted from left palm, pivoted clockwise then placed back down on left palm.

**Make**

Pinky side of right "S" hand rests on top of thumb side of left "S" hand, palms facing in. Hands are pivoted in opposite directions several times, striking each other gently after each twist.

**Thine, Thy**

Push the right flat hand forward, palm facing forward and fingers pointing up, heavenward.

**Heart**

Middle fingers are used to traced out the shape of a heart on upper left chest.

**Own**

Fingertips of both bend hands are placed on chest.

**Royal**

Right "K" hand, palm facing left. touches left shoulder, then is brought down to touch right hip.

**Throne**

Both hands are held palms down with index and middle fingers extended and curved, held in front of body. Bring both hands back toward chest in a slight arc motion.

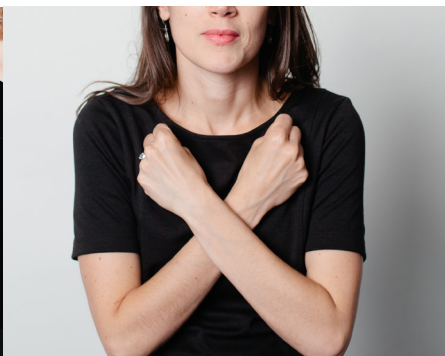

**Anyone**

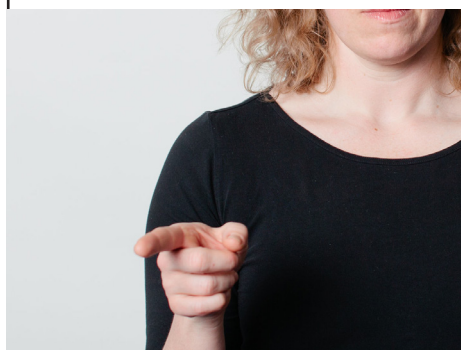
Thumb of right "A" hand leads in tracing an s-shaped curve in front of the body. Then bring right hand up with index finger extended up and palm forward.

**Loves, Love**

Fists are crossed on chest, palms facing body.

**Me**

Point to self with right index finger.

**He, Him**

Point right index finger forward.

**Word, Words**

Tips of right index finger and thumb are held about an inch apart as they are brought to touch index finger of extended left index finger.

**Father**

Tap thumb of right "5" hand on forehead a few times.

**Come**

Move right pointer finger in a slight arc towards self.

**Make**

Pinky side of right "S" hand rests on top of thumb side of left "S" hand, palms facing in. Hands are pivoted in opposite directions several times, striking each other gently after each twist.

**Home**

Place fingertips of right and hand at near chin moving toward the cheek with a slightly curved hand.

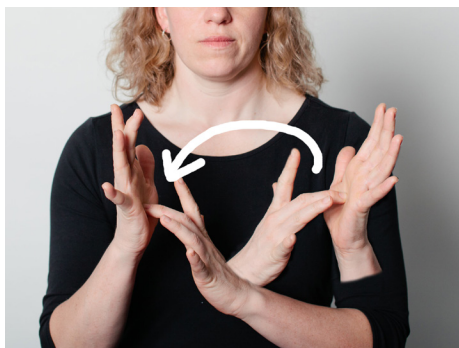

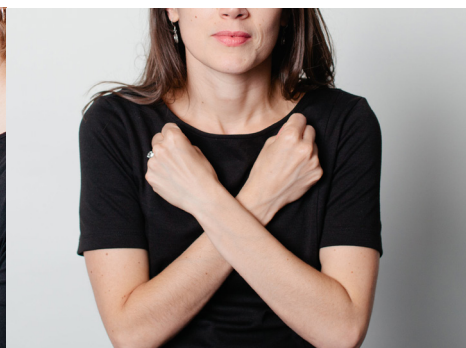

**Jesus**

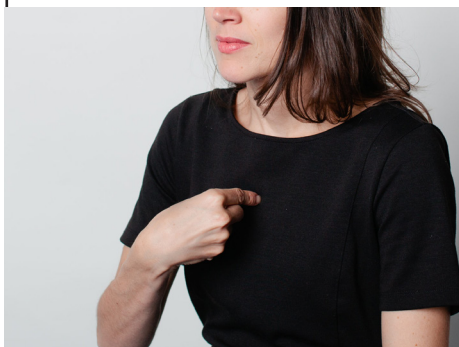

Hold right index finger in front of lips with left hand, also with extended index finger, held slightly in front of right. Pivot both hands forward and down until facing forward.

**Loves, Love**

Fists are crossed on chest, palms facing body.

**Me**

Point to self with right index finger.

**Obey**

Hold both "A" hands at head,, palms facing in. Then bring both hands forward, ending with them in the flat-hand position, palms facing up.

**Word, Words**

Tips of right index finger and thumb are held about an inch apart as they are brought to touch index finger of extended left index finger.

**Father**

Tap thumb of right "5" hand on forehead a few times.

**Come**


Place fingertips of right and hand at near chin moving toward the cheek with a slightly curved hand.

**Home**

Place fingertips of right and hand at near chin moving toward the cheek with a slightly curved hand.
