Instead, we seek other things to worship in His place. Nonetheless, there is none like the LORD, who is perfect in power, love and purity. He is holy!

**Holy**  
Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up, changing into a flat hand as it moves down left palm.



**Thee**  
Right open hand moves up a short ways from shoulder height.



**Eye**  
Right index finger points to right eye.



**Sinful**  
Both "X" hands, held near sides with palms facing up, move upward and outward in circles simultaneously.



**Glory**  
Middle finger of right hand touches upturned left flat hand, then is wiggled back and forth as it is raised up.



**See**  
Index and middle finger of right "V" hand, palm facing in, are placed near eyes then moved forward.



**Only**  
Right index finger, pointing up, palm facing body, is rotated counter-clockwise once.



**Power**  
Both "S" hands, palms facing body, are thrust forward and up in unison.



**Love**  
Fists are crossed on chest, palms facing body.





**Among**  
Make a few circles with both upturned flat hands.



**God, Gods**  
Right open hand, palm facing left, is held up above head level then brought down and back in a slight arc, ending with a "B" hand at the upper chest level.




**None**  
Right open hand moves up a short ways from shoulder height.



**You, Yours**  
Right open hand moves up a short ways from shoulder height.



**Lord**  
Thumb of right "L" hand, palm facing left. touches left shoulder, then is brought down to touch right hip.



**Works**  
Move open hands, palms down side to side at the same time.



**2 x's**  
**Great, Wondrous**  
Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up. Then touch the thumbs and index fingers of both "T" hands to each other, right hand above left, palms facing each other. Draw hands apart in an upward motion.



**Things**  
Both flat hands, palms facing up, are lowered in front of chest, then moved slightly out to each side.



**Alone**  
Right index finger, pointing up, palm facing body, is rotated counter-clockwise once.

**O LORD of Hosts: Isaiah 37:16, ESV**



**LORD**  
 Thumb of right "L" hand, palm facing left. touches left shoulder, then is brought down to touch right hip.

**Hosts, Cherubim**  
 Fingertips of both hands rest on shoulders then pivot out and are flapped up and down a few times like wings.


**God**  
 Right open hand, palm facing left, is held up above head level then brought down and back in a slight arc, ending with a "B" hand at the upper chest level.



**Enthroned**  
 Slightly curved right "V" hand, palm facing down and slightly towards body, is brought back towards body and rests as a flat hand on the back of left "V" hand which is palm facing down.

**Alone**  
 Right index finger, pointing up, palm facing body, is rotated counter-clockwise once.

**Kingdoms**  
 Right "K" hand, palm facing left. touches left shoulder, then is brought down to touch right hip. Then hold both open hands, right hand over left, with the right hand making a circle over left hand.



**Earth**  
 Thumb and index fingers of downturned right "5" hand are placed on sides of downturned "S" hand. The right hand pivots back and forth while keeping light contact with left hand.

**Made**  
 Move open hands, palms down side to side at the same time.

**Heaven**  
 At head level, Right flat hand, palm facing down, makes a forward circle around left flat hand, palm facing down. Then both hands move out to each side while simultaneously changing them into bend hands.
