

Right open hand, palm facing left, is held up above head level then brought down and back in a slight arc, ending with a "B" hand at the upper chest level.


Inaccessible
Flat hands, palms down, are crossed in front of body.



Eyes
Right index finger points to right eye.

Blessed
Place thumbs of both "A" hands at lips. Change hands into flat hands, palms down, as you extend them down and forward.

Ancient of Days
Right hand holds onto an imaginary beard at chin and pulls downward.



Victorious
Both upright hands pretend to grasp imaginary flags and wave them in small circles at head height.

Name
Index and middle finger of right "N" hand are brought down to rest on index and middle finger of left "N" hand. Both sets of fingers are pointing outward diagonally.

Praise
Clap the right hand on top of the left hand several times.

Blessed

Name
Index and middle finger of right "N" hand are brought down to rest on index and middle finger of left "N" hand. Both sets of fingers are pointing outward diagonally.




Right open hand, palm facing left, is held up above head level then brought down and back in a slight arc, ending with a "B" hand at the upper chest level.



Forever, Ever
Downturned right "Y" hand moves up and away from body.

Belong
Link index fingers and thumbs of both hands, with rest of fingers extended. Move both hands back and forth a few times.

Wisdom, Wise
Bent finger of right "X" hand is moved up and down several times. Make movement from the wrist.



Might
Both "S" hands, palms facing body, are thrust forward and up in unison.

Changes
Right "C" hand starts palm facing up and left "C" hand starts palm facing down. Both are twisted to reverse positions simultaneously.

Seasons
Point fingers of left flat hand up, palm facing forward. Move index finger of right "D" hand in a full clockwise circle, beginning and ending with index finger pointing to "12:00."



Gives

Both modified "Z" hands are held at chest, then brought down and forward, as if giving something to someone.



Reveals

Right index finger is placed in left palm palm which is facing forward. Both hands move forward together.



Hidden

Right "A" hand, palm facing in, is brought up to rest under left flat hand.



Darkness

Open hands begin pointing up on each side of the body. They are both brought down in front of the face and further down until the right hand rests over the left across middle of chest.



Light

Hold both hands at chest level, fingertips together. Open hands into "5" hands as they move up and out to the side, palms facing out.



Dwells

Upturned thumbs of "A" hands move upward in front of chest in unison.




Fathers

Tap thumb of right "5" hand on forehead a few times.



Thanks

Touch lips with fingertips of both flat hands, then move hands forward until palms are facing upward.



Praise

Clap the right hand on top of the left hand several times.
