Holy
Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up, changing into a flat hand as it moves down left palm.



Saints
Right "C" hand is placed at right shoulder then moved down across chest, ending at right hip.



Thee
Right open hand moves up a short ways from shoulder height.



Casting Down
"O" hands are moved downward simultaneously.



Crowns
Both "C" hands, slightly modified, act out slowly placing a crown on the head.



Sea
Index and middle finger of right "V" hand, palm facing in, are placed near eyes then moved forward.



Cherubim, Seraphim
Fingertips of both hands rest on shoulders then pivot out and are flapped up and down a few times like wings.



Shalt Be
Right flat hand is held near right temple, palm facing face and fingers pointing up. Then move right hand out in a forward-upward arc.



Evermore
Downturned right "Y" hand moves up and away from body.



Holy
Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up, changing into a flat hand as it moves down left palm.



Thee
Right open hand moves up a short ways from shoulder height.



Eye
Right index finger points to right eye.



Sinful
Both "X" hands, held near sides with palms facing up, move upward and outward in circles simultaneously.




Glory
Middle finger of right hand touches upturned left flat hand, then is wiggled back and forth as it is raised up.



See
Index and middle finger of right "V" hand, palm facing in, are placed near eyes then moved forward.



Only
Right index finger, pointing up, palm facing body, is rotated counter-clockwise once.



Power
Both "S" hands, palms facing body, are thrust forward and up in unison.



Love
Fists are crossed on chest, palms facing body.

Saw
Index and middle finger of right "V" hand, palm facing in, are placed near eyes then moved forward.



Lord
Thumb of right "L" hand, palm facing left. Touches left shoulder, then is brought down to touch right hip.



Sitting on
Slightly curved right "V" hand, palm facing down, is brought down and slightly towards body, is brought back towards body and rests as a flat hand on the back of left "V" hand which is palm facing down.



Throne
Both hands are held palms down with index and middle fingers extended and curved, held in front of body. Bring both hands back toward chest in a slight arc motion.



Lifted Up
Both upturned open hands held in front of body and lifted up in front of the face.



Above
Move open hands, palms down side to side at the same time.



Seraphim, Wings
Fingertips of both hands rest on shoulders then pivot out and are flapped up and down a few times like wings.



Calling
Cupped right hand, palm facing in, is held at chin then brought forward a short distance in a slight arc.



Holy
Right "H" hand, palm facing left, slides from heel to fingertips of left flat hand, palm up, changing into a flat hand as it moves down left palm.
