
**Bountiful**  
Start with flat right hand on top of left S hand. Move right hand over and down thumb side of left S hand.



**Tongue**  
Point both "L" hands towards each other, then move each hand to the side twisting them from the wrist as they move outward.




**Breathes**  
Both open flat hands are placed on chest and moved forward and back off of chest a few times. (Simulating rise and fall of chest in breathing.)



**Light, Shines**  
"Hold both hands at chest level, fingertips together. Open hands into "5" hands as they move up and out to the side, palms facing out.




**Hills**  
Both "5" hands, palms facing forward and fingertips up, trace a wavy line like a line of mountain (or hill) tops.




**Descends**  
Right hand, index finger extended, moves downward a few inches.



**Plains**  
Thumb and fingers of both hands, palms facing up, are moved back and forth over each other, as if feeling imaginary soil in each hand.



**Distills**  
Hold both "And" hands together in front of body, then open hands, spreading fingers apart, as both hands move forward and to each side.



**Rain**  
Move both hands down as you wiggle the fingers.

**Alone (Only)**  
Right index finger, pointing up, palm facing body, is rotated counter-clockwise once.



**LORD**  
Thumb of right "L" hand, palm facing left. touches left shoulder, then is brought down to touch right hip.



**Made**  
Pinky side of right "S" hand rests on top of thumb side of left "S" hand, palms facing in. Hands are pivoted in opposite directions several times, striking each other gently after each twist.



**Heavens**  
Right flat hand is held slightly above head level with fingers pointing left and palm facing down. Hand sweeps in front of or over head in an arc from left to right.



**All, Everything**  
Left flat hand rests on back of right flat hand. Right flat hand is then brought up and around left hand pivots so that back of right hand rests in left palm.



**Starry Host**  
Point both index fingers up from face level, beginning with left index finger a bit higher than the right. Alternate pointing up and drawing back index fingers a few times.



**Life**  
Upturned thumbs of "A" hands move upward in front of chest in unison.



**Earth**  
Thumb and index fingers of downturned right "5" hand are placed on sides of downturned "S" hand. The right hand pivots back and forth while keeping light contact with left hand.



**Seas**  
Touch mouth with index finger of right hand a couple times (sign for water); Then move both hands forward in wavy motion.





**Spread Out**

Thumb and index fingers of downturned right "5" hand are placed on sides of downturned "5" hand. The right hand pivots back and forth while keeping light contact with left hand.



**Myself**  
Right "5" hand is placed on chest.
