**Big Question and Answer:** "What is God's love for His people like? It's more than they could ever deserve!"

**Bible Verse:** "Give thanks to the LORD for He is good. His love endures forever." 1 Chronicles 16:34

### **Bible Truth 1 Concept: God Blesses All People with Many Good Gifts**

God has given many good gifts to all people--whether they love and obey Him or not. He made this beautiful world for all to enjoy. He has given each of us a heart to know and love Him and others. He has given each of us a body to do many different, wonderful things. He provides the sun and rain, the hot and cold, to grow the food we need. He keeps all living things alive each day. These are just some of the many good gifts God has blessed us with.

Why did God give us these good gifts? To enjoy them, to understand what He is like, and to glorify Him for giving them to us. Everyone should glorify God for His many good gifts given to them, but especially God's people. They enjoy the same good gifts as everyone else and far, far more. God is their Heavenly Father and they are His dearly loved children. Jesus died to save them from their sins. The Holy Spirit lives inside them and helps them to love, obey and enjoy God. And one day, they will get to live with Him forever. These are the very best gifts of all. They are gifts that can be ours even today, if we turn from our sins and trust in Jesus as our Savior.

**1. GETTING STARTED: Welcome and Opening Songs** (*introduce unit and get kids moving with these songs*)

God's people are sinners. Their love for God is never the same. They do not seek Him or obey Him as they should. Yet, the LORD's love for them is always steadfast. It never changes. That's because it's based on Jesus' perfect life and love, not on sinful life and unsteady love. God's people rejoice in how good God is to them! They give thanks to Him for His always faithful love. It will never, ever end. It truly is more than they could ever deserve.

**2. DIGGING DEEP DOWN: Key Concept and Story** (*introduce the Bible Truth and tell the related story*)**Bible Truth 1**

"It's time for us to dig down deeper for answers to our Big Question. We're learning **SIX** Bible Truths that all tell us something about God's love for His people. We are learning our first one today.

The Bible Truth we are going to be thinking about today is:

**God Blesses All People with Many Good Gifts.**

God has given many good gifts to all people--whether they love and obey Him or not. He made this beautiful world for all to enjoy. He has given each of us a heart to know and love Him and others. He has given each of us a body to do many different, wonderful things. He provides the sun and rain, the hot and cold, to grow the food we need. He keeps all living things alive each day. These are just some of the many good gifts God has blessed us with.

Why did God give us these good gifts? To enjoy them, to understand what He is like, and to glorify Him for giving them to us. Everyone should glorify God for His many good gifts given to them, but especially God's people. They enjoy the same good gifts as everyone else and far, far more. We use them to buy many good things that we enjoy. When people praise us for good/important things we do, that is a good gift from God, too. We all like to be encouraged and valued. These are good gifts, but they are not the best gift. The best gift we can have is when we become one of God’s people and God, Himself, is our treasure and inheritance. That makes riches and people’s praise worth almost nothing (“empty”) in comparison.</p>

**As you listen to the story, see if you can figure out:**

**1. Who was the general? What gift was he seeking? Why would it be odd if he received this gift?**

**2. What gift did he find that he wasn't looking for?**

*(If desired, write these questions on a sheet of paper to refer to when the story is finished.)*

*Read story.*

*After reading story, ask for the children's answers to the questions.*

**1. Who was the general? What gift was he seeking? Why would it be odd if he received this gift?** General Naaman. Healing for his leprosy. He was the enemy of Israel. He had fought against and killed the people of Israel, God's people.

**2. What gift did he find that he wasn't looking for?** He found faith in the LORD and salvation in Him.

*Close in prayer. (prayer suggestions included at end of story)*

**LESSON 2 STORY**

**Story of the  
Saints:**

**The Case of the

"Now it's time for today's story called: **The Case of the Father-like Love.**

**As you listen to the story, see if you can figure out:**

**1. Who showed the Father-like love? Which father was her love like?**

**2. Who did she show this father-like love to? Why was that so hard?**

*(If desired, write these questions on a sheet of paper to refer to when the story is finished.)*

*Read story.*

*After reading story, ask for the children's answers to the questions.*

**1. Who showed the Father-like love? Which father was her love like?** Corrie ten Boom (and her family). Her Heavenly Father: God.

**2. Who did she show this father-like love to? How was her love like God's?** She showed it to the Jews who needed a safe place to hide as well as to the Germans who took her prisoner and treated her and her family so cruelly. God gives good gifts to all, even those who do not love or obey Him. Corrie treated the Germans, who were so cruel to her, with kindness and love. She wanted them to come to know Jesus as their Savior, too.

*Close in prayer. (prayer suggestions included at end of story)*

<p><b>New Testament Story:</b></p> <p><b>The Case of the King Who Kept His Mouth Shut</b> Acts 12:20-35</p>	<p>"Now it's time for today's story called: <b>The Case of the King Who Kept His Mouth Shut.</b></p> <p><b>As you listen to the story, see if you can figure out:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>1. Who was the king? Over what was he made king?</b></li> <li><b>2. What did he keep shut about? What should he have done instead?</b></li> </ol> <p><i>(If desired, write these questions on a sheet of paper to refer to when the story is finished.)</i></p> <p><i>Read story.</i></p> <p><i>After reading story, ask for the children's answers to the questions.</i></p> <p><b>1. Who was the king? Over what was he made king?</b> King Agrippa. He was made king over all of Judah.</p> <p><b>2. What did he keep shut about? What should he have done instead?</b> The people praised him for being a god. He should have instead turned their praise to the Lord instead of keeping it for himself.</p> <p><i>Close in prayer. (prayer suggestions included at end of story)</i></p>
